Territory Incorporated (A) 5785 Centennial Center Blvd #230, Las Vegas, NV 89139

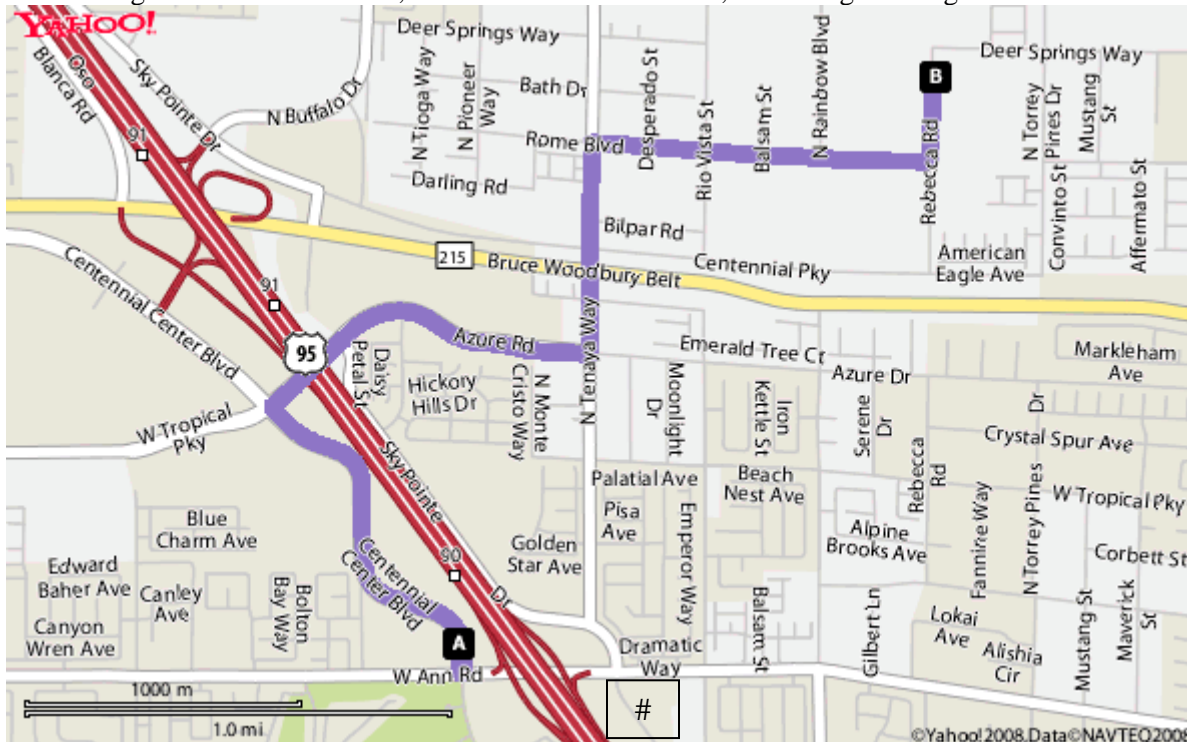
